**Creationtide, or The Season of Creation**, is a season in the Church calendar in which Christians around the world focus our attention on God's creation and humanity's responsibility as good stewards. The season runs from 1<sup>st</sup> September to 6<sup>th</sup> October when we will celebrate our Harvest Festival. While its adoption was in part driven by the complex environmental crises the human race faces, Creationtide draws on much deeper roots in Scripture and in older Christian traditions of the relationship between God, humanity and the created order.

At St Paul's, we will be engaging with Creationtide in several ways including special liturgy, music, homilies and prayer stations. Our own Bishop Richard will be preaching for us on 15th September. I would be grateful for your support in creating prayer stations: one for each of the 'seven days of creation' found in Genesis. These will need to be in place by the beginning of September.
