**Creationtide, or The Season of Creation,** is a season in the Church calendar in which Christians around the world focus our attention on God's creation and humanity's responsibility as good stewards. At St Paul's, we are engaging with Creationtide in several ways including special liturgy, music, homilies and prayer stations. Our own Bishop Richard is preaching for us today. The season runs from 1<sup>st</sup> September to 6<sup>th</sup> October when we will celebrate our Harvest Festival. We hope you will make time to enjoy all that Creationtide has to offer.

**Food Bank.** As in recent years we will be supporting our local food bank at harvest this year. **Collection:** During this service we will take a collection to support the work of the Church. Many people instead choose to contribute by direct debit. However you may choose to pay, contributions can attract Gift Aid if you are a UK taxpayer. This augments your contribution by 25% with no additional cost to you. Higher rate taxpayers can also claim back the difference between the rate they pay and the basic rate on their donation. Certain rules apply.
