Update on Moving towards opening the Church for Public Services

Revd Susan together with Church Wardens and others have been working towards opening the Church for services. The first service with a congregation will be **Evening Prayer on September 6th**, and the first **10.00 a.m. Eucharist service** with a congregation will be held on **September 13th**. These will also be **livestreamed on St Paul's YouTube channel**. Both these services will be trials of the new arrangements, so numbers will be tightly limited and **you will need to book places in advance** with **Guy, Parish Administrator**, at office@stpaulsparkside.org.uk. If these trials go well we expect services in September to continue with a larger congregation. However to allow for social distancing there will still need to be an upper limit on places available so we may have continue for a while with a booking system.
